1. Explanatory note

The relevance of the problem of adaptation of foreign students is determined primarily by the tasks of their further effective training as specialists. Successful adaptation contributes, on the one hand, to the rapid inclusion of students in the educational process, which allows us to so problems of maintaining the student body, which can be significantly reduced (up to 30%) during the first sessions. On the other hand, it helps to impropulately of training of foreign students in Kazakhstan's higher school.

Foreign students, having specific ethnic and psychological characteristics, are forced to overcome various kinds of psychological, social, religious barriers, to master new types of activities and forms of behavior.

The adaptation of foreign citizens to new socio-cultural conditions when entering a higher educational institution is a fundamental factor deter in most cases the effectiveness of the educational process as a whole. Therefore, successful management of the educational process for them is an i part of solving the problem of adaptation.

According to the theory, "adaptation" is the process of an individual's adaptation to a new educational and social environment, as a result of wh individual's compatibility with this environment should be achieved, new "ways of survival" should be learned – certain knowledge and norms of beha certain integration of the individual into the new environment should be achieved.

Based on the analysis, the problems of teaching foreign students in higher education can be grouped as follows:

- linguistic (mastering the local language and professional terminology in the chosen specialty and understanding the language of teaching);
- ethno-cultural (language barrier when communicating with locals and classmates, peculiarities of national cuisine);
- personal security (problems of tolerance, national tolerance and conflict situations with local residents and representatives of other nationalities o religious denominations);
- documentary support (registration and visa support; filling out various documents, questionnaires and forms, without taking into account the leproficiency of foreign students in Russian; nostrification of documents on education received abroad);
- · financial (general financial problems during university studies, technical problems during banking operations, etc.)



2. Program Structure

The purpose of the program is to create a socio-cultural environment conducive to the successful adaptation of students of the new set to the educ Tasks:

- 1. Creating conditions for the adaptation of foreign students to a new cultural and social environment.
- 2. Creating a favorable psychological atmosphere.
- 3. Assistance to foreign students in quick adaptation at the university and finding a common language with Kazakhstani students.
- 4. Education of a culture of behavior, prevention of offenses of negative social manifestations.
- 5. Promotion of a healthy lifestyle among foreign students.
- 6. Familiarization of foreign students with the traditions and culture of Kazakhstan.
- 7. Assistance in revealing the inner potential, originality and wealth of the individual.

3. Program Content

- -ordering of interpersonal relationships of students and their influence on the formation of personality;
- -introduction of missing elements of life activity into the life of foreign students, accelerating the process of adaptation;
- -prevention of the negative component in the behavior and communication of students.
- 4. Professional adaptation:
- -assistance in the successful implementation of the tasks of the educational program, professional development.
- 5. Physical (physiological) adaptation:
- -assistance in quick and painless adaptation to local conditions (climate, food, etc.) without harm to health; prevention of diseases.
